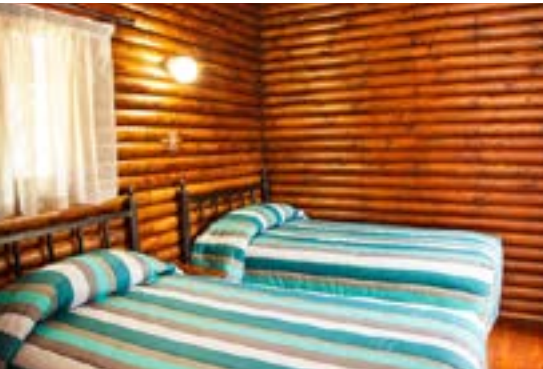

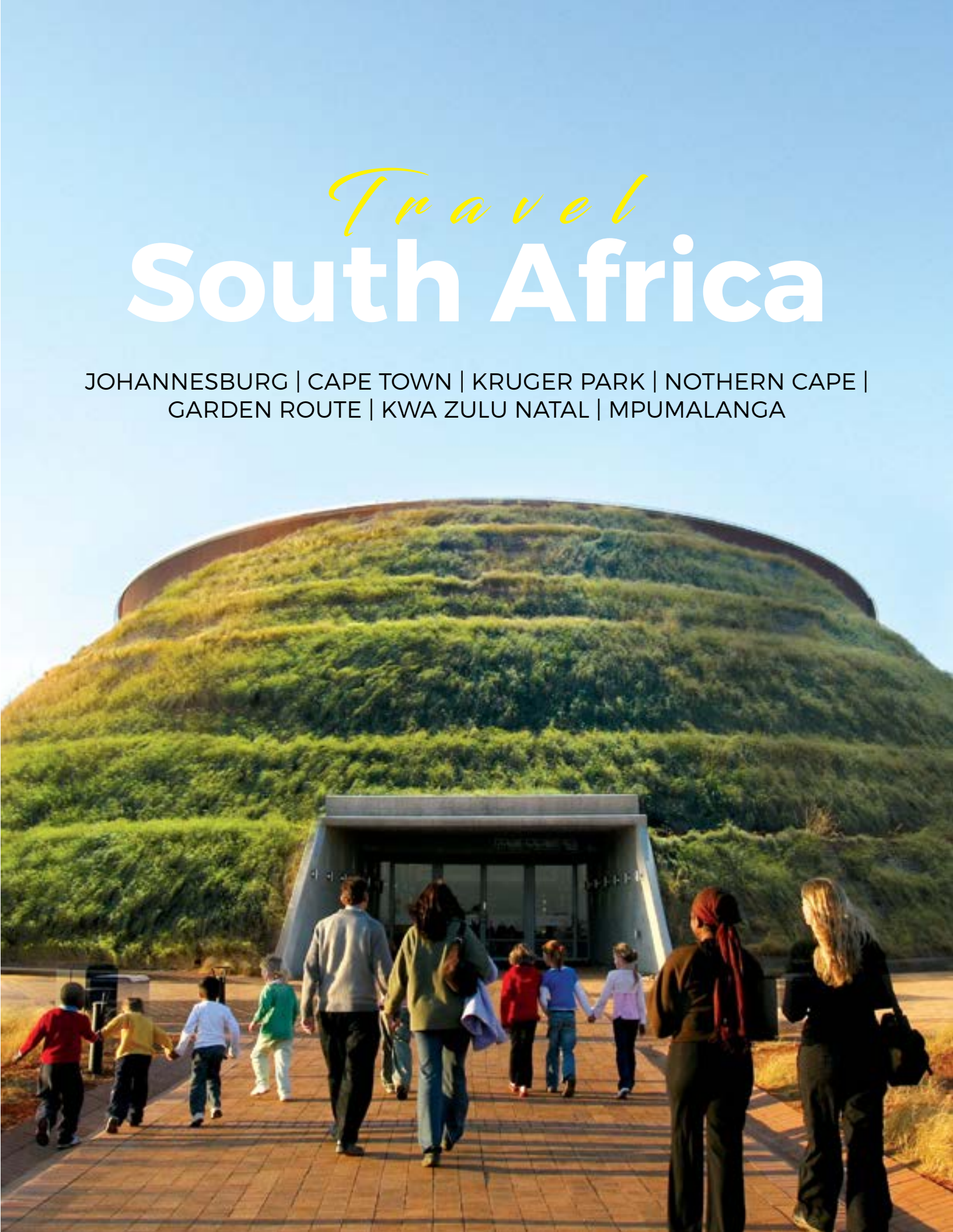

Kimberley was one of the first really big towns to develop in the Cape, after Cape Town. Fuelled by the very profitable diamond mining industry, the magnates invested in everything of the best and have left us with a rich and very interesting canvas of their life and times.

Itinerary

The Kimberley Mine Museum

Situated at the biggest hole ever made by man with pick and shovel, so strong was the desire for diamonds. The original mining village has been restored true to its historic background of the 1870's diamond rush. The Eureka, the first recorded diamond discovered in South Africa, can be viewed at the museum.

You can have fun sifting through diamond bearing gravel, to find your own diamond or experience a diamond mining operation, with blastings, and you will soon feel like a miner. Play skittles in the old bowling alley, or just stroll through the old buildings and soak up the life and times. Food and refreshments are available at the Occidental Bar.

Kimberley Africana Museum

Apart from one of the finest collections of Africana, much used for research purposes, the library houses the missionary Robert Moffat's translation of the Bible into Tswana. (Moffat was the first man to translate the Bi-

ble into an African language).

The building housing the Kimberley Africana Library was opened on 23 July 1887. The collection comprises books, manuscripts, maps, photographs and other documentary material on Kimberley, the Diamond Fields, the Northern Cape, archaeology and geolo-



gy and many thousands of items celebrating the region's past and its role in the history of South Africa and indeed of Africa. The highlights of the collection are the books, pamphlets in indigenous languages dating from 1826 as well as records by early European travellers to the region and material dealing with the Anglo-Boer War (1899-1902). The Special Collection, primarily of European origin, includes examples of early printing which date from 1475, and manuscripts dating from the 17th century.

Sol Plaatje Museum

Sol Plaatje is perhaps the most forgotten of South Africa's black leaders who exerted a profound influence on our political transition from colony to democracy – and all the exceedingly painful steps in between – but whose legacy seems to have been sadly eclipsed by the generation of iconic African National Congress (ANC) icons such as Nelson Mandela, Oliver Tambo and Walter Sisulu who emerged in the 1960s. The museum is very small (only a couple of rooms, plus a reference library) and also houses the Sol Plaatje Educational Trust. In addition to information on the sieges of Mafikeng and Kimberley, the exhibit also has a couple of interesting posters on black and coloured involvement in the Boer War (particularly in the Northern Cape).

McGregor Museum

Housed in a gracious building erected in 1897 as a sanatorium and later used by Cecil John Rhodes during the siege of Kimberley, the McGregor Museum features a collection of natural history specimens and Bushman (San) relics. Other exhibits reflect the early history and development of Kimberley, including the most opulent period in the history of the city.

Rudd House

Formerly the lavish home of HP Rudd, a mining magnate, it was built in 1888. It was restored to its full grandeur by the McGregor Museum. It was declared a national monument in 1990. This house only viewed by appointment with the McGregor Museum.

Duggan-Cronin Gallery

An outstanding collection of some 8 000 photographs of the indigenous people of Southern Africa taken between 1919 and 1939 by Alfred Duggan-Cronin, an Irish mine manager who was also an excellent photographer. Labourers were recruited from most of South Africa's tribal people to work on the mines. In those days, they retained their traditional hairstyles, face markings and clothing, but items have changed and such a unique collection never be compiled again. Historical background is provided.

Memorial to the Pioneers of Aviation

Kimberley was the "nursery" of flying in Southern Africa. On the site of South Africa's first flying school, established in 1913, the museum features a reconstruction of the original hangar, a replica of the Compton-Peterson biplane used in flight training, and photographs of the early days of aviation. During World War II, many pilots were trained in Kimberley under the Empire Air Training Scheme. The flying school led to the establishment of the South African Air Force. The Pioneers of Aviation Museum stands at the site where the story of aviation in South Africa began and where the first flying school was based. It includes aviation displays and a replica of a Patterson Biplane.



Magersfontein Battlefield -

This famous Anglo-Boer War battlefield was the scene in December 1899 of a fierce battle between Boers and British soldiers. A field museum containing displays of uniforms, equipment, weapons, documents and photographs relating to the battle is situated on the site. The old Boer trenches can still be seen from the hilltop. The museum has displays on the battle. All our museums are closed on Good Friday

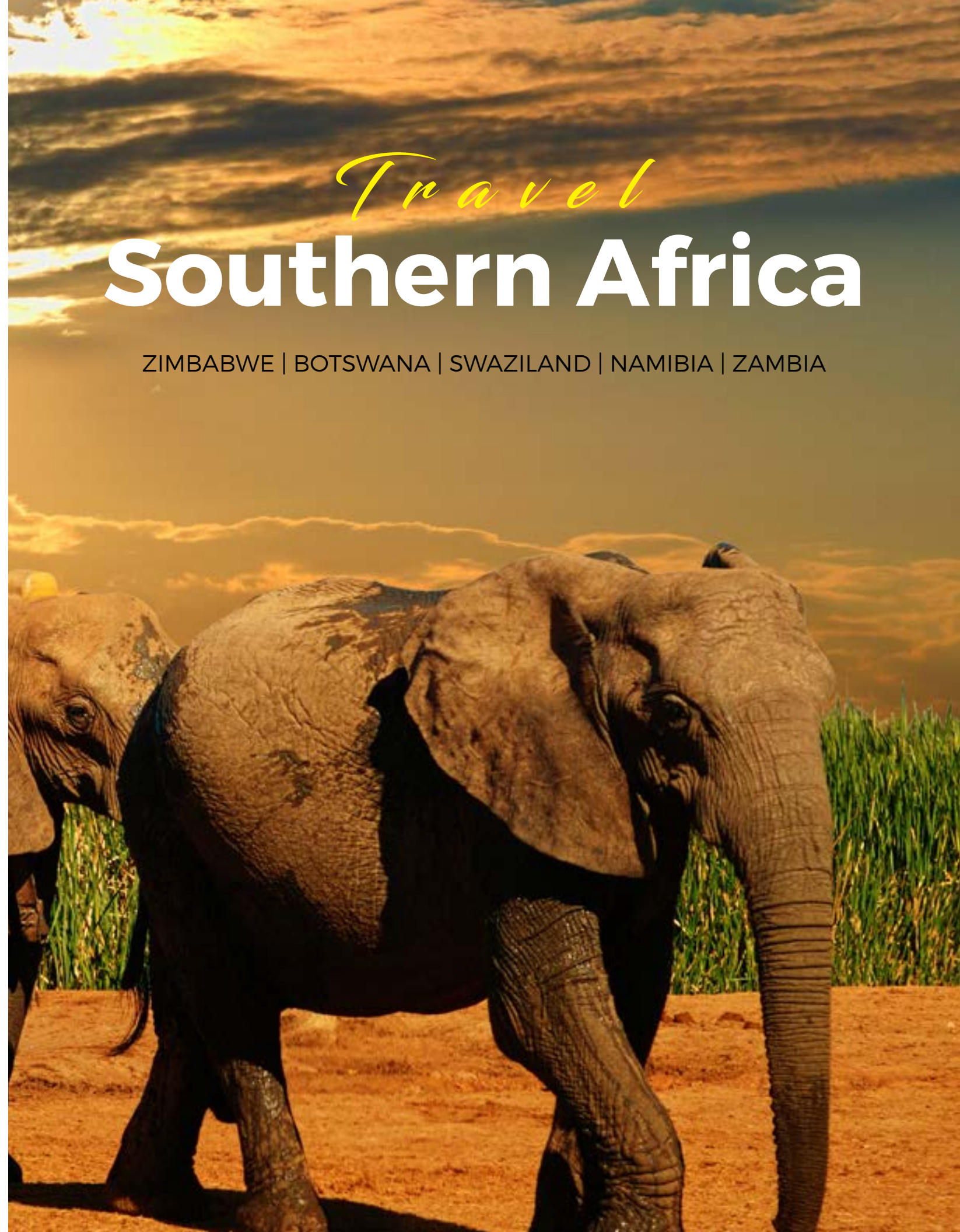

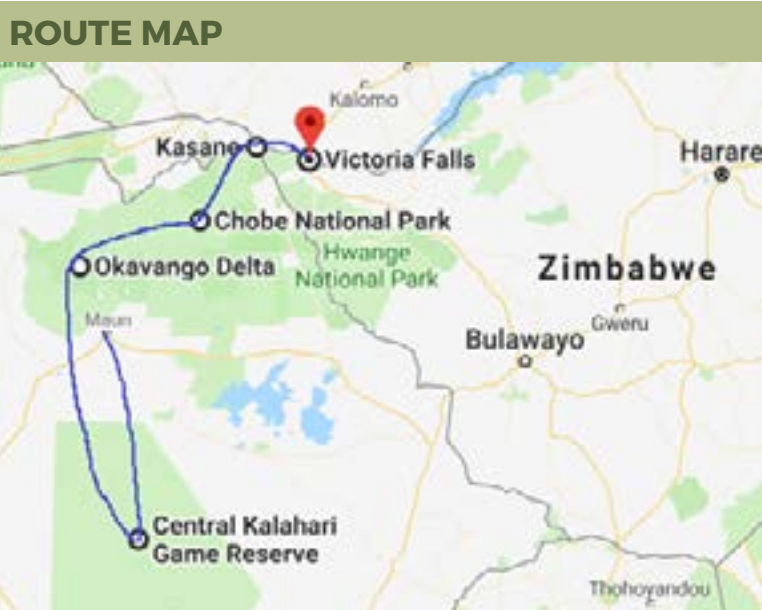

Grasslands Safari Lodge can accommodate up to sixteen guests in well-furnished chalets, each with en-suite bathrooms and ceiling fans. Each chalet has a running hot and cold water supply with laundry done at no extra charge. The main building has both outdoor and indoor dining areas, overlooking a large swimming pool.

As cradle of one of the most enigmatic civilizations in history and home to 11 UNE-SCO World Heritage Sites listed, Peru is quite a special destination as you will discover over seven fascinating days exploring the country. Visit beautiful colonial cities, impressive archaeological sites and discover some of the most spectacular landscapes on the planet en route to the magnificent Machu Picchu citadel and mountain. Groups vary in size but are typically made up of about 6-10 travellers. Tour Cities:

Lima - Cusco - Sacred Valley - Pisac - Ollantaytambo - Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu - Cusco - Puno - Lake Titicaca - Uros - Puno

ITINERARY:

DAY 1: INTERNATIONAL ARRIVAL- LIMA

- A transportation service will wait for your arrival at the Lima Airport and transfer you to your hotel.
- Overnight at selected hotel in Lima.

DAY 2: LIMA / CUSCO- CITY TOUR AND AR-CHAEOLOGICAL SITES (HD)

- After breakfast, a transportation service will pick you up from your hotel at the established time and will transfer you to the airport of Lima.
- A transportation service will wait for your arrival at the Cusco Airport and transfer you to your hotel.
- You will be accompanied by a guide who will inform you about the attractions the city has to offer and assist you along the way.
- You will start your tour visiting the Coricancha, also known as "The Temple of the Sun" (QuriKancha "Golden Temple"), which was built by the Inca Pachacutec and at the arrival of the Spaniards became the basis for the construction of the Santo Domingo Convent. Here, during the Inca Empire reverence was surrendered to the sun ("Inti"), and there was a time when it was covered with gold. Then visit the Cathedral, the most imposing monument in the Plaza de Armas. Its construction began in 1560 and ended only in 1654. For this purpose hundreds of stones were extracted and transported from Sacsayhuaman fortress under the command of the Eccle-

siastical Council. You will continue your tour to the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, one of the most emblematic buildings of the Incas (located just minutes from town center) built by the Inca Pachacutec in the fifteenth century. This is a huge fortress built with large stones whose transportation remains still a mystery. Each June 24th, during the winter solstice, the feast of IntiRaymi is recreated here, where the sun is worshipped. Continue to Quenqo, located 4 kilometers from the city of Cusco. Quenqo is an archaeological complex of mainly religious use where it is believed agricultural rituals were performed. Finally get to know PukaPucara, located 7 kilometers from the city of Cusco. PukaPucara, which means "Red Fortress", was an architectural complex of alleged military use with multiple spaces, plazas, baths, aqueducts, walls and towers, and it is believed the entourage of the Inca used it while he rested in Tambomachay. Return to the hotel.

- Overnight at selected hotel in Cusco. Breakfast included.

DAY 3: SACRED VALLEY - PISAC - OLLANTAYTAMBO (FD)

- Breakfast at the hotel. You will start your tour at the Pisac market, which has stands that exhibit and sell products manufactured by the residents of the area. Beautiful alpaca textiles, musical instruments, paintings, carvings, neck-



laces and replicas of old Inca pieces stand out. You will continue to the Pisac archaeological site, which has the largest complex of terraces in the area and is a masterpiece of the agriculture of the Inca Empire. Next, you will have lunch at the previously agreed restaurant and then you will visit Ollantaytambo, making a series of stops at points of interest. The Ollantaytambo town, a typical example of the urban planning of the Incas, whose residents still live in accordance with their old traditions. Pachacutec conquered the town, destroyed it and built a new one, absorbing it as part of his empire. It exhibits one of the most remarkable complexes of the Inca Empire. You will return to your hotel in Sacred Valley.

- Overnight at selected hotel in Sacred Valley. Breakfast and lunch included.

DAY 4: SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO (FD)

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel and a transfer to Ollanta train station. Your tour to Machu Picchu begins with a train ride to Aguas Calientes in approximately two hours' time. This town is also known as "Machu Picchu pueblo" and is the last stop before entering the





remains of the most important archaeological site in Peru. In Aguas Calientes there is a craft market, restaurants and hotels of different categories for those who prefer to spend the night at the foot of the mountain and climb it early. Finally, after a short transfer by bus you will reach Machu Picchu, a masterpiece of engineering and architecture that served as a sanctuary and retreat for the Inca Pachacutec. Machu Picchu, which means "Old Mountain", and is considered a World Heritage by the UNESCO and one of the new Seven Wonders of the World. Once in the citadel you may optionally also visit the Intipunku (Sun Gate), the Wayna Picchu (subject to space availability) and the Inca Bridge. Return to Aguas Calientes for lunch at Café Inkaterra. After lunch, board the train back in the afternoon.

- Overnight at selected hotel in Cusco. Breakfast and lunch included.

DAY 5: CUSCO – PUNO (FD)

- Begin the day with breakfast at the hotel.



Then, transfer to the bus station. Travel by bus to Puno through the breathtaking scenery of the Andes. Your journey will have three stops. The first one at Andahuaylillas, a town located 40 kilometers from Cusco whose main attraction is the Church of Andahuaylillas, also called the "Sistine Chapel of America" due to the high quality art found in it; the structure was built in the sixteenth century on sites possibly inhabited by the Wari civilization. Today it houses a recently restored original pipe organ. You will continue your journey to Racchi, where the Temple of Wiracocha is, a surprising rectangular building, 30 meters wide and 20 high, similar to a wall with windows and doors. You will stop for lunch in Sicuani, and then make a brief stop at La Raya, the highest point of the way between Puno and Cusco, 4313 meters over sea level. From here, 61 kilometers from the city of Juliaca (very near Puno), you will reach the village of Pucara, where the Lithic Museum Pucara is located. This town was the first urban settlement in the lake itself and developed between



100 and 300AC. Finally, undertake the last journey to the city of Puno and then to the hotel, where a representative will assist you with your check in.

DAY 6: PUNO / LAKE TITICACA - UROS & TAQUILE (FD)

This island is Quechua, unlike the other islands in the lake being Aymara speakers. The Island was part of the Inca Empire and vestiges of that culture can still be seen in its buildings. Once there you will be given a brief explanation of the island and witness a cultural activity. Then eat lunch and return to the city of Puno.

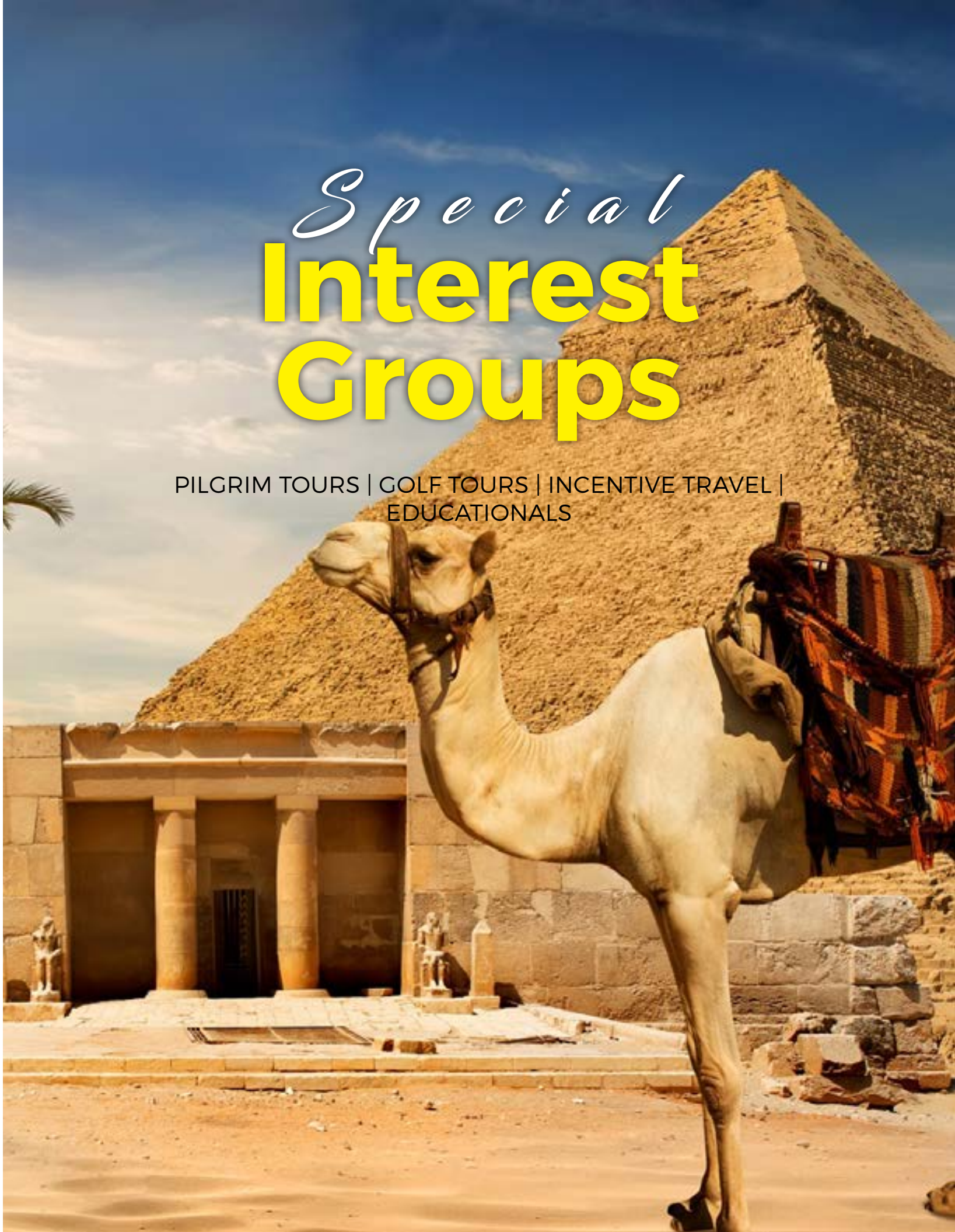

With the simple change of tossing a spill-proof tumbler and/or a reusable, eco-friendly water bottle into your bag, you're set. This is the #1 most important change that you can make that will keep your trip greener.
2.

Unplug your home: Before you leave your home for a trip, whether it's a weekend trip or a three-week-long trip, unplug everything in your home. Even if you're not using something, just having it plugged in seeps energy from the grid. This not only saves electricity but also saves you money.
3.

Pack lighter: This may seem insignificant, but packing light has a huge environmental impact. If your bag is lighter (let's say you pack just one suitcase instead of two) that means the plane will weight 50lbs less, the bus you ride or the car you drive will be just as light, and each one of those changes means the fuel consumption will also be less.
4.

Use public transportation or walk: While we may not always want to take the bus/rail, mass transit is by far the greener way to travel on land as it uses a reduced amount of fuel per passenger as compared to a car. Even better, when possible, why not walk? One of the best ways to see any place and experience the local intricacies is by walking around, and it's great for your health too!
5.

Eat local: Whether you're traveling or not, purchasing local food/products means that nobody had to drive those goods across the country just to get them there. Buying or eating the local produce also encourages local businesses. Let's admit it, food is one of the 'tastiest' ways to get to know a destination. So, get that palate on a hunger hunt!
6.

Choose eco-hotels: There are many eco-friendly hotels/hostels popping up all over the world, which make great choices to help offset those emissions you caused by getting to the travel destination. These accommodations make their mark on the environment by ensuring they do the following:

Drink near beer: The term "near beer" is a new growing trend but it isn't a new concept. What it means is that wherever you are, drink the beer that's made nearby. Since you're traveling, why not drink the local beer? Not only are you being greener but you're also supporting local breweries. Cheers to that!
